Venue Note. For one day every 2 years the Rowland Flat Airfield becomes the busiest Airfield in SA, the rest of the time it is a wheat paddock with a natural surface runway on it. Permanent pathways and structures are not possible. This means that all the facilities are temporary, portable and easily removeable. These conditions make providing ideal accessibility facilities difficult but we make every effort to provide a safe, useable and inclusive venue for all people.

Getting there

Public transport

- Limited bus service between Gawler and Nuriootpa.
- The nearest stop is on Barossa Valley Way, about 1 km from the airfield entrance

Parking

- Accessible parking is available.
- An accessible drop-off zone close to the main entrance is available

Outside pathways to the main entrance

• The venue is an airfield that has minimal facilities. Access to the grounds can be uneven. A pathway will be cleared to the entrance gates but it could still be an uneven surface.

Entrance

- The Airshow Airfield will have the entrance area mowed but could still be an uneven surface.
- The entrance is through lines marked with bunting and pegs. No doorways.

Getting around and joining in

Special event

- An accessible drop-off point is near the main entry to the event.
- The area will be mowed but could still be uneven.
- 5 Accessible Toilets will be on the Airfield and will be clearly marked.
- Most service counters will be portable tables at approximately 700 mm. Some of the vendors facilities may not have a low-level service point.
- There is a designated accessible viewing area.
- A shuttle bus is not provided.
- Straw bales provide casual seating where people can rest throughout the event venue.
- We do not have a quiet space/sensory room.

Lifts

• There are no lifts at the venue.

Public toilets

- There are accessible public toilets that are Unisex
- The grounds will have been mowed but it could still be uneven.

Changing place

- We do not have a changing place.
- There is some access to running cold water only.

Customer care and support

Accessibility equipment

• We do not provide accessibility equipment.

Assistance/guide dogs

• A designated Assistance Dog toilet area will be available. The venue will be noisy, crowded, with frequent sudden very loud noises and low flying aircraft suddenly appearing. These conditions can be stressful for a dog so please consider the

welfare of your dog and be confident your dog will cope with the Airfield conditions. All accredited assistance dogs will be welcome on the grounds.

Staff, security and volunteer training

• Staff, security and volunteers have had disability awareness training to various levels.

Concessions

- There are no concessions for disability pension card holders'
- Companion card holders and carers are given concessions.
